All Species

All animals MUST enter grounds at Gate 1.

Gate 1 will be open 24/7

Health Inspections will be conducted at time of entry at the Gates.

All animals must have a valid Health Paper with Official USDA Identification.(Including all transit animals)

Beef Cattle

All Beef Cattle will be required to have a USDA 840 EID Tag. This includes all transit and sale cattle.

All cattle shall be reported negative on an ELISA or PCR BVD-PI test that has been collected by an accredited veterinarian. The results and date of the test shall be recorded on the CVI issued for entry onto the KEC for the NAILE.

All Open Show Bulls will be weighed prior to entry in the show ring. Heifers may be weighed as well up to the discretion of the breed association and will be published in the Premium Book.

Prospect Calf Show-All entries will be singles, both Steers and Heifers, Sale will be optional at the time of entry. 40 head must be consigned at time of entry for the sale to be conducted. Entry fee - \$50.

Steer Show-Grand Champion to receive \$20,000, Reserve Grand Champion to receive \$10,000 Grand and Reserve will remain terminal

Junior Heifer Show- Electronic Papers will be accepted at check in. If the electronic papers are not tattoo verified- heifer must have her tattoos checked at check in.
